Hi Max

I do not have access to a printer, so I am unable to do this myself.  
Can you please print out and serve the paperwork as directed by the District Court.

I have attached a copy of this appeal notice.  
It was written under a lot of stress, but hopefully it will be good enough for the moment.  
This appeal notice was done without receiving any help from you, and help is still needed.  
Any help you can offer needs to be sent to me before the end of September to give me a chance to

update the notice.

As I needed to take the 13th September off work anyway, I managed to send off some paperwork, but unfortunately it does not match what the court wanted, so that part will need to be done again. I have attached what I managed to send off on 13 Sept 2018.

Can either side of a legal dispute discuss this dispute with a Magistrate, Registrar or Judge without the other side being present, or a representative being present ?

What specific law prevents this, if any ?

This information is needed before the end of September to give me a chance to update the notice.

A bill has been presented to the District court for taxation by the defense, and I would like a copy of it. Partly to see if they are trying to bill for a hearing where I was excluded, and therefore admitting to it, and partly as a foundation for my own bill of costs.
