- Grounds of Appeal;
- Submissions;
- Legal Authorities;
- Orders wanted;
- Draft chronology; and
- Draft appeal book indexes.

For more information on the contents of these documents please refer to Rule 32 (3) to (9). You must pay a fee when lodging the appellant's case.

Specimen draft appeal book indexes can be found on the Supreme Court website. Please do not alter the style or the formatting of the indexes.
